Shown at the top of page 68 is a document which authorizes the Dutch Postal Service to collect 222 Guilder and 45 cents for the invoices listed. The invoices, August 24 and 27, 1932, totaled this amount after the credit given on the company's invoice of August 27, 1932. There is also a 10 cent documentary tax against payment on the invoices. The Post Office collects the monies involved and then the document becomes a check payable to the company's account. There is an endorsement (not
