
Confirmation of S321's User



This is a confirmation of the positive identification cover for perfin S321. Douglas Cutler (L126) in his position as US Catalog Editor reported positive user

identification for perfin pattern S321 in the June 1992 edition of *TPB*. At that time, he also noted that the picture in *The Catalog of United States*
