## Improvements in the Cataloging of Perfins


"Perfins of the Comptoir National d'Escompte de Paris" by Jan Prins appeared in the July/August 1976, edition of The Perfins Bulletin. The illustrations that accompanied that article are reproduced later in this article along with the same illustrations from the new catalog, Timbres Perfores: France et Colonies. The intent is two-fold: 1. To illustrate the improvements in cataloging since 1979, and 2. To publicize the French Catalog which is available from our Catalog Sales and Distribution Chairman. The Prins' article as been reproduced here followed by some of the illustrations out of the newer catalog.

## "Perfins of the Comptoir National d'Escompte de Paris"

The Comptoir National d'Escompte de Paris, one of the largest banks in France, was founded on June 11, 1889. They are affiliated with the French American Banking Corporation in New York (perfin FA/BC).

Apart from a few hundred branches in France, they had offices in Algeria, Tunisia, Monaco, and Madagascar. In the last-mentioned country, there were three branches, at Tananarive, Diego Suarez, and Majunga. In Port Said (Egypt) the Comptoir National d'Escompte de Paris had a branch, and



the perfin C.N. can be found on the stamps of the French post office in Port Said.

In Egypt, two perfins C.N. were used, and in Tangier (Morocco) the perfin C.N. has been found on the stamps of the German Offices in Morocco.

In Europe, the CNE has branches in

Great Britain (London), Belgium (Brussels), and in Spain.

In the beginning, the CNE perfin was used, but later there was a change to the CN initial. To avoid confusion, it should be noted that two CN types of France were not used by CNE, but by other firms listed below.
