The cover illustrated at the top of this page has a corner card listing "Clay, Robinson & Company, Stock Yards, Kansas City, Mo." In addition this April 24, 1915 mailing is franked with a 2 cent red Washington head punched with perfin pattern C292. This pattern, CR/K, is listed in *The Catalog of United States Perfins*, by the Baloughs as being used in Kansas City, MO., but no user is listed.

While the letters CR/K are not an exact match for Clay, Robinson & Company they may possibly stand for <u>Clay</u>, <u>Robinson</u> & Company, <u>Kansas</u> City. I forwarded a copy to John M. Randall, US Catalog Editor. John's reply was:
