

# Clay, Robinson \& Company - C292

The cover illustrated at the top of this page has a corner card listing "Clay, Robinson \& Company, Stock Yards, Kansas City, Mo." In addition this April 24, 1915 mailing is franked with a 2 cent red Washington head punched with perfin pattern C292. This pattern, CR/K, is listed in The Catalog of United States Perfins, by the Baloughs as being used in Kansas City, MO., but no user is listed.

While the letters CR/K are not an exact match for Clay, Robinson \& Company they may possibly stand for Clay, Robinson \& Company, Kansas City. I forwarded a copy to John M. Randall, US Catalog Editor. John's reply was:

Thank you for the photocopy of the cover, which is a new identification . . . .

Keep up the good work of finding new identifications. /s/ John.
