The Catalog of United States Perfins shows "N. Shellenburg Company of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania as the user of perfin patterns N158A and N158B. The illustrated 1917 cover (see page 36) franked with a 2 cent red Washington stamp punched with perfin pattern N158B shows a different spelling and the addition of an ampersand (&) before "Company." The address of Market Street, Eleventh to Twelfth Streets also provides us with the company's location.

Since patterns N158A and 158B are "NS/&Co", I suggest that both catalog entries should be corrected to read, "N. Snellenburg & Company". If anyone has a cover showing a different name, it would be helpful for the US catalog Editor to make a final determination. A photocopy of my cover has been forwarded to the US Catalog Editor.
