## C167 - Railway's Full Name

One of the problems associated with production of the various editions of *The Catalog of United States Perfins* has been the rigid format used on identification pages required frequent use of abbreviations. While there is a listing of the abbreviations used, it is often inconvenient to be flipping back and forth in the catalog. The next edition of the catalog -- now in preparation -- will have fewer entries on a page and through the use of computer set type abbreviations will be uncommon, if not eliminated. Pattern C167 user's entry currently is listed as "Chicago & IL Midland Rwy." Reference to this December 8, 1961 posting (shown at the top of page 177 photographically cropped in order to fit our pages) enables us to provided the full name of, "Chicago & Illinois Midland Railway Company." The 4¢ Lincoln is punched with the railway's CIM -- perfin pattern C167.




