



The first 'S.G.'perfined (perforated initialed) stamp was issued on February 8, 1900. This was part of the remainders of the 5 milliemes provisionally overprinted stamps of 1897 which was an obsolete stamp. All official mail was sent with this stamp regardless of weight or distance. These stamps were used as a control of official mail rather than postage, and were used instead of a manuscript franking by a responsible official.

OFFICIAL JAPAPNESE PERFIN



This cover sent from Tokyo on October 16, 1920 bears the official perfin of the Japanese Admiralty. The cover was sent to the Vatican by then Commander I.Yamamoto. He was considered by the Japanese next to the Emperor and an ideal Japanese. Yamamoto, a Catholic, was probably used as a liaison between Japan and the Vatican in the diplomatic relationship established in 1919. Yamamoto planned and executed the attack on Pearl Harbor in 1941.
