I noticed the above Stock Transfer Slip, which is
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partially illustrated on the previous page, while organizing the "Rev-Perf" material that Joe Miller has been loaning me for a possible catalog on the many unrecorded US perfins design. The 1934 document was used by Adler, Coleman & Company. The slip has a US revenue and a New York State Stock Transfer stamp with clear punches of perfin design A92.5(AC/Co).

The Catalog of United States Perfins, by Balough and Balough, 1979 does not list an identified user for this design. The initials are a perfect match for the catalog name and the US Catalog Editor should consider this as a positive identification for the user of perfin pattern A92.5. The editor will have to struggle with the city of origin. The above document was used at the Adler, Coleman & Company office located at 15 Broad Street, New York, NY while the catalog currently lists Boston, Massachusetts as the city of origin. I assume that Adler, Coleman had an office in Boston, MA and hopefully our research will confirm this.

In the US Catalog, this design is rated B if found on US postage. On US revenue stamps the pattern is relatively common and if rated on revenues, it would probably
