

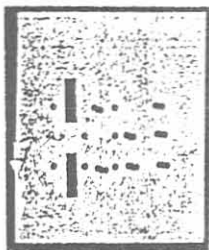
What happened to this Schermack?

Al Glass (#2840) wonders what caused the strange Schermack illustrated here.

The control perfin (pattern 19) on the Schermack III (Scott 344) had serious problems in the Kabo Corset Company affixing machine.



The Schermack slot perforation is properly centered.



The control perforating device put one set of perfins correctly in relation to the cut stamp but then something went wrong and three additional sets of perfins were applied almost one on the other! In addition to being seriously miscut there are several small internal tears around the perfin which may have occurred at the same time.
