

New pattern and new identifications reported for Bavaria

It's true: new information does arrive the minute a catalog or update goes to press. Jerry Soutar (#68-L) sent along these additions and corrections to *the Catalog of Bavarian Perfins* with the compliments of German specialist Rainer von Scharpen. You will want to note these changes in your copy of the Bavarian catalog.

- **Pattern A21** (ALLIANZ) was used by Allianz Versicherungs A.G. (*correcting a typographical error*)
- **Pattern A33** (A&Z) was used by Althoff & Zorn, Mechanische Buntwerberei, Färberei, Bleicherei u. Zwiernerei. (*more complete identification*)
- **Pattern G12** (G.F.) was used by Gebrüder Fetten, Herrenkleiderfabrik, München. (*new identification*)
- **Pattern K18** (K.&M.) was used by Kupfer & Mohrenwitz (*correction of identification based on new evidence*)
- **Pattern S5** (S.B.) was used by S. Bach, Kgl. Preuss, Hoflieferant. (*correction of typographical error*)

And Bob Schwerdt reports a brand new pattern on Bavaria. The O.S. shown here was found in a collection Bob acquired recently.
