## Far Eastern Republic

Dick Scheper (#3311) has added a new country to the world perfins listing: the Far Eastern Republic.

The republic was formed in





the aftermath of the Bolshevik Revolution in Russia. It was located in northeastern Siberia just east of Lake Baikal. The shortlived republic issued only 74 different stamps (according to Scott) before joining the

Soviet Union in 1923.

The Cyrillic letters X.K. in the perfin, according to Scheper, stand for *Kharbarovsk Kontora*, the post office in the Siberian city of Khabarovsk. That apparently makes it an official perfin, but little more is known. Does anybody have more information?
