Learn (#3265) opened the cover, he found a reproduction of a 1910 postal card picturing Hoag Studio of Ottawa, IL. Mershon & Morley noted that the studio building is a "No. 05 Portable Photograph Gallery" manufactured by their firm. They were especially proud that it is a single roof and single wall construction that was standing up to 1 Illinois winters: "you can judge the stability 龠 of our construction when our single roof 1 and single wall gallery stands the test this 200 one has." A price list included with the IAN2P () 12 - M postal card listed the cost of the 12- by 25-

foot building at \$272.93. If you wanted to add a porch to the studio or any of the company's other portable buildings, it would cost you an additional \$9.83 per section. Mershon and Morley advertised themselves as manufacturers of "summer cottages, automobile garages, photograph galleries,

open air cottages for tuberculosis patients, 👘 children's play houses, hunters' cabins" as well as regular cottages and bungalows. Window screens were listed at \$1.35 each, wooden 🕋 awnings could be added to the windows for \$4.00 each, and "double walls" and "double roofs" could be added to buildings 🕋 sent to colder climates.
