
More perfin on the Small Queens of Canada

Michael Behm (#1902) says



there is a fifth perfin known on the Canadian Small Queens issue (see the January 1998 *Bulletin*, page 3). It is the I.T/Co. pattern of

the Imperial Tobacco Company of Montreal. Behm says it is known on the 3¢ value.

He adds that there is actually a



sixth pattern known on the issue—but the sixth pattern is a “favor” perfin. Sometime after 1933, Behm says, somebody perforated at least three of the 3¢ Small Queens with the CPR (C51) pattern of the Canadian Pacific Railway.
