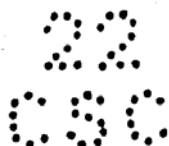

As we have an occasional "Queries" page, it is nice to be able to answer it with a "Queries Answered" page. The above cover belongs to Reg Powell and proves that the perfin 'cLc' does indeed originate from "London County Council" rather than "City of London Council".



Harry Skinner has sent me an example of a damaged strike of Marples "Shamrock" perfin which looks just like the "↓" perfin illustrated in the last issue. It seems clear that the design illustrated as No. 119-37 in the Lindt Catalogue is just a damaged Shamrock.



Following the article on 22/CSC, Jack Brandt sends a die IV of this identity and suggests we may be looking at a number of slightly different dies in multi-die machines. He also points out that from about 1912 a significant increase in hole size of die III is evident.
