
## HIS MAJESTY'S FACTORY



From members reports we have now identified dies three which HM/F. Only two of originate from appear to HM Factory. The first die has 2 mm between the upper and vertical lower lines the aligns with and of the F the vertical of the H. Die II characterised is by small misshapen holes and the distance between lines is 3 mm. the F and H do not align. Both these dies are known low value KG V issues postmarked in CARLISLE and GRETNA in 1916/8 are attributed to HMFactory. Die Ш SO has 2 mm spacing but the F and H do not align. It is known **FOLKESTONE** 1902/5 postmarked in and is consequently probably not official. The most likely user being Hotel Metropole, Folkestone, which would have provided stamps for its patrons.
