

- Type 1 : H has eccentric dot and left leg curved
- Type 2 : H has short left leg which is not straight
- Type 3 : M has right leg curving out at bottom
- Type 4 : O badly deformed
- Type 5 : M has right leg curving in at bottom
- Type 6 : H has vertical strokes out of alignment
- Type 7 : M has both legs curved
- Type 8 : M has top hole of right leg high
