A number of CSC/22 examples are known which are simply offsets of the original three, but this is one different, being much smaller in size. Tillies No. is Its C698A and I have it on a Victorian ½d issue with a London (Newspaper Branch) postmark which, of course, is undated but the stamp identifies it as prior to 1887.

Has anyone seen any other examples, or can it to be identified definitely with Cook Son & Co.?
