Illustrated is an interesting 'perfin' courtesy of member PADDY MURPHY. After much research I believe this to be a piece of Victorian stamp selvedge. It is printed with the value 2½d, has a Tooting duplex cancel and the perfin F.P/C.L, possibly of Foster, Porter & Co Ltd.



There were lots of other possibilities, amongst them a bleached out fiscal or overprinted foreign stamp.

If you can confirm what it is please let me know. It definitely provided lots of exercise for the little grey cells.
