The perfin is listed in The Catalog of United States Perfins as L52, Lansing Company, Lansing,

MI. There are supplementary entries for Lansing Company of Delaware; a Boston, MA location; and an A&C entry for New York City. This cover confirms that Additions and Corrections entry.

Shown below are the envelopes contents. These include a letter dated 6/1/16 about concrete mixers. However, the brochures which were also enclosed tells up about the company's line which were manufactured by the Ideal Engine Company. This may explain the Lansing, Michigan entry in our catalog. The Chairman of the Ideal Engine Company was R.E. Olds. Is there an Oldsmobile connection here?
