



Recently, while compiling the 'V' section for the New Illustrated Catalogue, I was all set to include the perfin 'VE' as a new die. As the letters were well centred (on an E7 1d, postmarked London WC, 7/4/1902), there was no reason to suspect it was a partial until John Nelson sent me 'VE&' on an E7 ½d(bl-gn).

Clearly a much larger die was involved, but what did it look like? Some 10 years ago Harry Skinner reported a full strike of the die CLIVE (C4522.01) shown here as partials 'CLI' and 'IVE'.



Working on a hunch that this new die could also be CLIVE, I searched through my notes and catalogues and came up with three more examples - CLI (C4520.02), LIV (U2190 - since deleted), and IVE (unpublished, but originally from Ron Brown on an E7 1d).



Can anyone add any more pieces to the jig-saw? Was someone else involved or did it all end in an anticlimax with &C°!
