

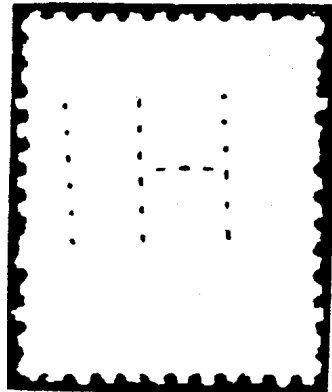
'L&S/B' PERFIN WITH ARROW-HEAD SHAPED HOLES Bulletin 280/11.

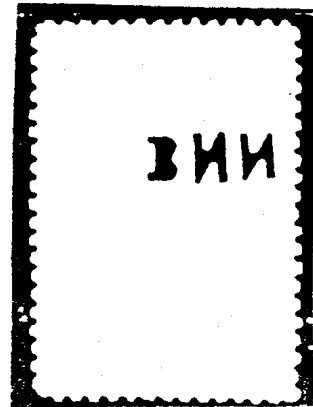
