CURRIE LINE WEIGHS ANCHOR

Currie Line, one of Scotland's oldest and largest shipping, warehousing and haulage companies, has been acquired in a management buy-out from parent Anchor Line.

Currie Line was incorporated in the 1790's as the Hull and Leith Shipping Company and changed to its present name in 1940. Anchor Line acquired the company in 1968 and was in turn acquired by the Swedish company AVENA in 1990.
