

A new OHMS perfin from Sierra Leone

Sierra Leone has been on the front pages of the world's newspapers recently because of internal unrest and U.N. involvement in peace-keeping efforts. The

World Perfins Catalog lists only two perfins from Sierra Leone:

an unidentified A&E/TCLd and the 2/WIR pattern used by the Second West Indian Army Regiment in Freetown. Bob Schwerdt has come up with a third pattern: an O.H.M.S/No.2 which he discovered on a copy of Scott 117 used as a revenue (it has a manuscript date cancel). The user isn't known, but the OHMS would indicate official use of some sort. Can anybody provide further information?
