Mexican District Revenue Perfins

Because of the Latin American census and the upcoming revision of the Americas Section of the World Perfins Catalog, it is time to learn more about a delightful little-known batch of well-engraved Mexican revenues.

Most are dated and depict individuals or scenes from Mexico or Mexican history. They're usually overprinted and show purple or black oval cancels. Several perfin strikes and dark cancels tend to obscure some of the stamp design.

However, in the hope that other members may have some examples of these stamps with additional parts of the perfin patterns showing, I'll list my small accumulation. You will need a strong glass to examine these stamps.

Perhaps we can generate enough information to warrant including them in the updated catalog.
