
## New State of Illinois Pattern Surfaces Bob Combs (LM 24)

In his recent mail Bob Combs spotted what appears to be a new perfin for the State of Illinois. Alongside two stamps perfinned with the familiar I0.5 Bob noted a new pattern that is smaller (5 1/2 mm vs. I0.5's 6mm) and punched with pins of a smaller diameter. The new pattern is punched through a copy of the current  $34\phi$  Statue of Liberty stamp. Below is a copy of the stamps on cover. The illustration of the pattern is presented simply to show a comparison of the old and new pattern. (Editors note: I created the illustration of the patterns using Photoshop to "invert" the pattern). Bob wonders if anyone else has a copy or copies of this new pattern?
