Help Wanted – U.S. Revenue Catalog

I am currently working on the perfins section of the proposed revenue catalog. So far, this section will contain 1,012 perfin designs with all the revenue data associated with them. 648 designs have been found in postage and are shown in the Catalog of United States Perfins.

While analyzing these designs I discovered that 75 of them do not have any detailed revenue data. Some of them came to my attention based on the "R" that the U S Catalog editor used to indicate that they were found in revenue stamps. Others were reported to me, but the reporters failed to provide me with the types of revenue stamps in which the perfins were found.

Revenue perfins have been found in all types of State and Federal stamps such as, documentary, stock transfer, future delivery, proprietary, wine, liquor, narcotic, silver tax:, tobacco, playing cards and oleomargarine. It is important that the proposed revenue catalog shows this type of data.

I have prepared a graphic listing of the perfin designs in which we need confirmed revenue information. Please check your collections and accumulations against it. You may have a revenue copy as a space-filler in your collection that you plan to replace when you acquirer a copy in a postage stamp. Please check the stamp face of the designs shown in the listing.

In your duplicates and accumulations a revenue stamp can easily go unobserved, especially in low rated perfin designs. Please check the stamp faces. Based on our past experience, scarce revenue perfins are usually found in documentary stamps. If you find any, your efforts will be rewarded because many of these low rated perfins become high rated in revenue stamps.

I will need a photocopy or a scan of both sides, or you can loan it to me and I can check it out, copy it and return it the same day! We will include the new data in the final catalog with a credit for your help. My address is on the back cover.
