This is the third part of the up-date of the Postal Stationery Cards with a perfin die through the stamp on the card. The original article was in Bulletin 284/13-19; up-date in Bulletin 343/16-17.

Since the original article was printed in 1996 I have had reports of 30 new dies on these cards. I always thought the P.S. Wrappers had the most common usage but I now reserve my judgement until I have up-dated all the new information appertaining to the Wrappers.
