CIRCULAR DELIVERY COMPANYS STAMPS 1865-67.

THESE STAMPS ARE OF LIMITED FRANKING POWER, ISSUED BY PRIVATE FIRMS WHICH HANDLED MAIL DESTINED FOR DELIVERY WITHIN LIMITED AREAS. COMPANIES WERE FORMED BY ROBERT BRYDONE, AND HAD OFFICES AT ABERDEEN, DUNDEE, GLASGOW, EDINBURGH, LIVERPOOL AND LONDON. THEY UNDERTOOK THE DELIVERY OF CIRCULARS AT A RATE OF POSTAGE MUCH BELOW THE 1^d THEN CHARGED BY THE POST OFFICE. WHEN THE SERVICE HAD BEEN IN OPERATION FOR A FEW MONTHS THE POSTMASTER GENERAL BROUGHT ACTIONS FOR INFRINGEMENT OF MONOPOLY AGAINST THE COMPANIES, AND EVENTUALLY SUCCEEDED IN STOPPING THEM.

COLLEGE STAMPS, 1871-84

THESE WERE SPORADICALLY USED BY THE TWO PRINCIPAL UNIVERSITIES OF OXFORD AND CAMBRIDGE BETWEEN THE YEARS 1871 AND 1884, BUT WERE FINALLY SUPPRESSED BY THE POSTMASTER GENERAL IN DECEMBER, 1885.

KEBLE COLLEGE, WHICH HAD BEEN THE FIRST TO INTRODUCE STAMPS, DEFIANTLY CONTINUED TO USE AN ENVELOPE AND A POST CARD UNTIL 1886, AND EVEN THEN PRODUCED AN ENVELOPE WITH THE COLLEGE ARMS EMBOSSED ON THE FLAP, WHICH WERE SOLD AT 6^d A DOZEN, WHICH FRANKED LETTERS — BY MEANS OF THE COLLEGE PORTERS — TO ANY PART OF OXFORD. THIS DODGING THE POSTMASTER-GENERAL WENT ON FOR MANY YEARS.

FIVE YEARS AFTER KEBLE ISSUED ITS FIRST STAMP, MERTON FOLLOWED SUIT, HERTFORD IN 1882, ALL SOULS AND ST JOHN'S IN 1884, WHILE BALLIOL, HAVING PREPARED A STAMP, WAS TOO LATE IN 1885 TO MAKE USE OF IT.

ONLY THREE CAMBRIDGE COLLEGES FOLLOWED OXFORD'S LEAD — QUEEN'S IN 1883, AND ST. JOHN'S AND SELWYN IN 1884.

PRIVATE TELEGRAPH COMPANY STAMPS

OF THE STAMPS OF THE PRIVATE TELEGRAPH COMPANIES, FEW COLLECTORS COULD PUT UP A REPRESENTATIVE DISPLAY. THE REASON IS NOT FAR TO SEEK, OF THE GENUINE ISSUES FEW EVER CAME INTO PRIVATE HANDS. AS IS THE CASE TO DAY, THE STAMPS BOUGHT FOR TELEGRAPHS SELDOM FOUND THEIR WAY OUTSIDE THE POST OFFICE. THE PURCHASER OR CLERK STUCK THEM ON THE FORM TO BE DESPATCHED, OBLITERATED THEY WENT FORWARD ON THE FORM TO THE DESPATCH DEPARTMENT, FROM THENCE TO THE COMPANY'S FILES, FROM THENCE TO THE PUMPING MACHINE AND OBLIVION. WHEN THE PRIVATE COMPANIES SOLD OUT THEIR INTERESTS TO THE POST OFFICE IN 1870, A FEW UNUSED REMAINERS CAME ON TO THE STAMP MARKET, THE GREAT DULK OF THE STOCK OF STAMPS AND FORMS TAKEN OVER BY THE POST OFFICE WAS DESTROYED.

THE "MAGNETIC TELEGRAPH COY." WAS INCORPORATED IN 1851; A YEAR LATER IT OBTAINED A ROYAL CHARTER WITH THE NAME OF "THE ENGLISH AND IRISH TELEGRAPH COY." IN 1857 A MERGER WITH THE "BRITISH TELEGRAPH COY." WAS ARRANGED, THE COMBINED COMPANIES THEN OPERATED UNDER THE TITLE OF THE "BRITISH AND IRISH MAGNETIC TELEGRAPH COY. LTD."

THE COMPANY OWNED THE TELEGRAPH LINE FROM GLASGOW TO HELENBURGH KNOWN AS THE WEST HIGHLAND TELEGRAPH. IT WAS TAKEN OVER BY THE G. I. O. IN 1868.

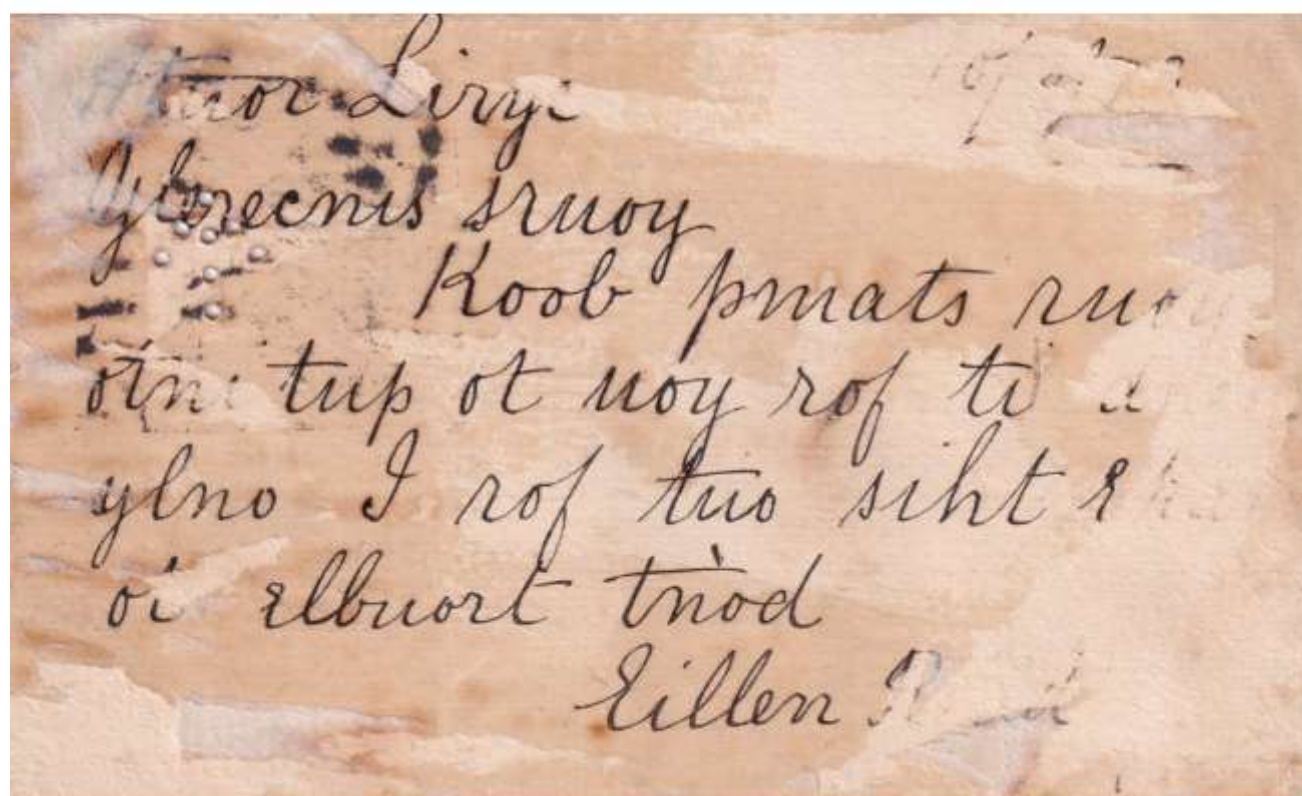
