## Note!



Horatio Edwin Emberlin (1816-1890) was born in Chelsea, s/o Edwin & Sarah Emberlin. He was living in Leicester in the 1841 census, described as a Traveller, where he settled and became a Grocer in partnership with Thomas Claridge (dissolved 14<sup>th</sup> January 1852). He later entered into partnership with William King (1803-1881), Cigar & Tobacco mfrs, Vestry St, Leicester. H E Emberlin JP also became a Leicester town councillor.







one 4x1 strip all prove a *single* headed die - 16 examples.


