Herman John Tagatz* Herman John Tagatz - Obituary.

Dies as Result of Being Kicked. 1911

Herman Tagatz died Tuesday afternoon at the Oconto County Hospital. On Aug. 24th he was brought to this city by officers of Lena, having been arrested there on suspicion that he was intoxicated. When he arrived here it was found that he was ill instead of being intoxicated, and after several unsuccessful attempts to communicate with his relatives in the hope that he could be properly cared for through their financial assistance he was taken to the county jail, where he remained until the next morning, when he was transferred to the hospital.

Tagatz was a horrible sight. His face and head were swollen to the size of a peck measure, and there was little human resemblance to his features. He was suffering with erysipelas, and there was a large quantity of puss beneath his scalp. He was given the best of care and medical treatment at the hospital and appeared to be getting along nicely until Monday, when he complained of a pain in his side, which grew worse until his death Tuesday afternoon.

A post mortem examination was held yesterday morning by Drs. Gaunt and Stoelting at the undertaking rooms of M. F. Manning, and we understand that they found a bad cut in his scalp near the top of his head, at the back, and that infection in the wound had caused the erysipelas. A coroners jury was impaneled, who viewed the remains and took an adjournment until the 14th insl, when testimony will be introduced. No testimony was taken yesterday.

Tagatz informed Sheriff Barns and others that he had been kicked by a man at Green Bay. He could not remember the man's name, but stated that he had written the name and all the particulars on a piece of paper, which could be found among his effects. He stated that while in a Green Bay saloon he was attacked by this man, and that in order to avoid him, he left the place and crossed the street but was followed by the man and assaulted. He was knocked down and kicked in the head and body. He was then taken to a livery stable in Green Bay, where he remained for two days, when he went to Lena, where he was arrested and brought here.

Deceased was at one time a prominent and wealthy businessman at Beaver, Marinette County. Two brothers who came here to look after him accompanied his remains yesterday to Montello, his former home, for burial. Oconto County Enterprise

Obituary

Herman J. Tagatz being the fourth son of Christoph Tagatz and was born in Crystal Lake, Marquette County, Dec. 28th 1870. He attended the German school at Crystal Lake, and the teacher being Mr. J. Weseloh, whom a great many will remember. From there he came to Montello with the Tagatz family and attended the public school in connection with German school, Rev. Sauer being the teacher. Rev. Sauer confirmed him at the age of thirteen years, and then Herman went to Northwestern University at Watertown, Wis. In the fall of 1885 where he prepared himself as a teacher and received his diploma in the spring of 1889. He accepted a position at St. Johns' Ev. Lutheran school, where he stayed about a year and then came back to Marquette county. In 1890 he went to Madison and attended the telegraphy school. He was operator at Amherst, and in 1891 was night operator at Menominee, Mich; from there he returned to Marquette county and taught in the public schools of Mecan and Shields, and then went north to Marinette county, where he taught school at Big Wausaukee. In 1895, Mr. Tagatz went to Beaver, Marinette County, Wis., and engaged in Mercantile business, where he had very good success and made a fortune for himself. In the spring of 1895 he was married to Miss Emma Matz, of Germania' to them six children were born, two of whom are dead, the other four with their mother are residing at Germania.

Mr. Tagatz had a good business at Beaver and was doing nicely: in 1907 he sold out his business at that place and move to Germania, Wis., later coming to Montello and traveled back and forth to different places. In July, 1911, he went to Green Bay and remained there about five weeks, when on a Saturday night he was assaulted by three toughs and knocked down and kicked by them in the head. He neglected to consult a physician at one and after a few days erysipelas set in. By his request the Poor Commissioner of Green Bay sent him to Lena, Wis., and from there, Henry Tagatz, his brother, sent him to the Oconto hospital on Aug. 25, where he was doing nicely until Sept. 5th, when his heart, the pump of human life, gradually failed, and at about four o'clock that same day he breathed his last. The cause of his death being erysipelas. The remains of the deceased were accompanied to Montello by his two brothers, Emil and Henry Tagatz, on Thursday night, Sept. 7th. The funeral services were held on Friday at the home of his father' Rev. Oswald Theobald officiating. Internment being in the Montello cemetery. An aged father, four brothers, one sister and a number of other relatives are left to mourn his death.

Dr. Theodore (Ted) H. Zabel of Yorktown Heights, New York died suddenly at home on Saturday July 10 at the age of 56. Born on June 14, 1948, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, he was the second son of Harold and Sylvia Zabel. During his early years at school, he was a star athlete and musician as well as being Valedictorian of his High School.

Dr. Zabel also distinguished himself at college, earning a Bachelor of Arts, Cum Laude (1970), a Master of Physics (1973) and a PhD in Physics (1976) from Rice University in Houston Texas.

His first post-doctoral position was at the Australian National University in Canberra, Australia, where he wrote 11 papers on advanced topics in nuclear physics and also married his New Zealand born wife, Jane Jones.

The family then transferred back to the USA, where Dr. Zabel took up a position at Tucson Arizona where he established an accelerator based Radioactive Dating Laboratory. This laboratory, under his guidance, pioneered work using accelerators for dating old artifacts and is still a world center for that work.

Dr. Zabel moved to a position as Research Engineer at IBM Research Center in Yorktown Heights, New York in 1984. His first mission there was to commission a major new accelerator in the T. J. Watson Laboratory. In this work, Dr. Zabel's knowledge of nuclear physics and his skills in designing and carrying out the most demanding experiments made him a valued colleague of many in the laboratory. Dr. Zabel's work was meticulous and his data invaluable to numerous colleagues both in and outside of IBM.

He is survived by his beloved wife Jane Jones and his adored and adoring sons Joshua and Nicholas Zabel.

In lieu of flowers, the family requests that memorial gifts be designated to the Dr. Ted Zabel Memorial Fund. These gifts may be sent to Rice University, Office of Development, MS-81, PO Box 1892, Houston, TX 77251-1892.

He is also survived by his older brother, me, Bill Zabel. An autopsy revealed the cause of death to be congestive heart failure. After a brief private viewing, his body was cremated. There was no calling and no funeral.

As a sort of memorial service there was a "Celebration of the Life of Ted Zabel," held at an upscale reception hall in Yorktown Heights, with several dozen of Ted's colleauges in attendance. Hors d'ouvres were served by uniformed waiters during a cocktail hour, following which Ted was eulogized by a number of his colleagues. This presentation included a family slide show and a company slide show. Finally there was a buffet-style dinner.
