		Awards: Organize awards program for members and their dogs.
		Breed Education /Breeder Referral: Provide materials to help educate all people about Bernese Mountain Dogs. Organize events to get this information out to club members and the public. Maintain official Club Breeder Referral List. Be the contact point for people looking to get a Bernese Mountain Dog. Help educate them about the breed and get them in contact with breeders.
		<u>Draft</u> : Organize drafting workshops and clinics. Provide instruction and encourage members to try drafting with their dogs. Keep abreast of Draft Test rule changes by the BMDCA and help organize our fall Draft Test.
		Fun Match: Plans the biggest club event of the year! Plan, organize and run the Fun match event. Includes set up, stewarding, judging and recording results.
		<u>Health</u> : Promote the health and welfare of BMDs by providing relevant health information and education, encouraging participation in research on BMDs and organizing events to promote health related activities, such as clinics, seminars, etc.
		<u>Historian</u> : Documents the history of the club through collecting newsletters, flyers, meeting minutes and photos. Maintains a club scrapbook with that information in it.
		<u>Information Technology</u> : Maintains club web site. Develops club databases. Provides guidance on technology issues for the club.
		<u>Junior Membership</u> : Develops program of activities for Jr. Members. Helps expand the program by attracting more juniors to become members. Publishes newsletter for Jr. Members.
		<u>Membership</u> : Contact for prospective members. Provides club information and coordinates the application process. Maintains membership information in the club database. Publishes the membership directory.
		Newsletter: Collects information, photos and articles from club members for inclusion into the Club Newsletter. Develops prints and mails the newsletter to all club members on a quarterly basis.
		<u>Performance:</u> Promote working dog performance activities, including Rally obedience, agility, tracking, skijoring, therapy, herding, and more. Plan and organize educational workshops and practice events

<b>Supported Entry</b> : Works with the Board of Directors and the BMDCA to support the entry of Bernese Mountain Dogs at an AKC conformation show. Organizes sweepstakes if appropriate.
<u>Ways and Means</u> : Raise funds so the club can hold events for members. Responsible for raffles, and sales of merchandise at club events.
<u>Fund Raising:</u> Plan and implement campaigns to solicit funds from other members and the community through personal solicitation, auctions, events, etc.
