## KVA SPORTS ADDS BEACH VOLLEYBALL ATHLETES TO CLIENT ROSTER

Athlete representation firm signs three new athletes under partnership with PushPlay

IRVINE, Calif. – KVA Sports, an athlete representation firm headquartered in Orange County, has expanded its client roster to include beach volleyball players through a partnership with local agency PushPlay Sports & Entertainment Marketing. Today, KVA Sports announced the signing of three NCAA All-Americans: **Tina Graudina** and **Julia Scoles** from the University of Southern California (USC) and **Lexy Denaburg** from the University of California at Los Angeles (UCLA).

KVA Sports had previously placed an emphasis on professional baseball players, representing clients such as 10+ year MLB veterans Carlos Torres and Jerome Williams, as well as recent and current Major Leaguers Aaron Fletcher, Sam Gaviglio, Grant Dayton, Matt Dermody and Parker Markel. • **Tina Graudina** is a 3-time All-American, the 2019 *National Player of the Year* and the first NCAA beach volleyball player to qualify for the Olympic Games, representing Latvia in Tokyo this summer where her home country took 4<sup>th</sup> place. She

is currently a senior and plays for the #1 pair at USC, which won the 2021 National Championship.

- Julia Scoles of Mooresville, N.C., transferred from Hawai'i to USC as a graduate student last year. She is a 2021 All-American & played for USC's #2 pair on the 2021 National Championship Team; she's a former All-Big West Conference Selection (U of Hawaii) and former indoor volleyball All-ACC Selection (U of North Carolina).
- Lexy Denaburg, a sophomore from Merritt Island, Fla. is a 2021 All-American and played on the #1 pair at UCLA in the 2021 season. She won the USA Volleyball (USAV) U21 Beach Volleyball US Championship this past summer and will represent Team USA at the 2021 Beach Volleyball U21 World Championships in Thailand this December.

"We are very excited to work with the top collegiate players in the country and look forward to transitioning them into the professional ranks once their collegiate eligibility is complete," said Varricchio.

In addition to these top collegiate athletes, KVA Sports is currently discussing representation agreements with several current professional beach volleyball players and will announce those signings once they are finalized.
