After the parade, which ends on Palm Canyon Drive at Alejo Road, the festivities will continue with the Town Fair at Frances Stevens Park on the corner of Indian Canyon and Alejo Road. **This year's Town Fair will start at 12:00 p.m. and end at 6:00 p.m. and feature on-field performances, musical renditions, on-stage shows, and specialty booth displays.**

Included with fee: **\$50 cleanup deposit for food vendors, one-day City of Palm Springs business license, if not exempt, application fee, and 10' x 10' booth**
Heath Dept., City License and booth fee are non-refundable after two weeks prior to event.
NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED!

Operators with food booths must adhere to Riverside County Health Department Codes:

- Hats, hair nets, gloves, hot/cold storage, thermometer, hand washing areas, proper fire extinguishers, etc.
- Some duplication of sales items will occur, but the Palm Springs Black History Committee will determine the number of duplications.
- The first organization or person submitting the above Registration Form will receive priority.

Food servers should prepare for a heavy influx of people.
