Dressing for the Event

A white pageant dress attire and white gloves for formal wear for the girls is mandatory for all divisions and escort should wear a suit or tuxedo. You may dress accordingly for talent portion. Contact pageant coordinator concerning length & style of clothing. Dressing rooms and restrooms are available next to the stage **DO NOT LEAVE VALUABLES UNATTENDED.** **All formal wear must be presented during the dress rehearsal on Friday, June 7, 2024.**
