1. Introduction

Analytics cookies may be provided by services such as Google Analytics or similar tools.

3.3 Functionality Cookies

These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make, such as:

- language preferences
- form information
- other personalised settings.

These cookies help improve your experience when using the website.

3.4 Third-Party Cookies

Some cookies may be placed by third-party services used on our website, such as:

- payment processing services (for example Stripe)

- analytics services
- embedded content or integrations.

These third parties may collect information in accordance with their own privacy policies.

4. Managing Cookies

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through your browser settings.

You can usually:

- delete existing cookies
- block cookies from certain websites
- block all cookies.

However, blocking certain cookies may affect the functionality of the website.
