Online Employment Options

It's almost impossible to find employment in a foreign country no matter your skill sets due to language barriers and widespread poverty. The best way to keep a steady income is with an online job. There are many options available; provided below is a short list to help get your search started. We recommend securing online employment before traveling as most employers require drug tests, background checks w/ fingerprint scans, physicals, and in-person HR paperwork filling which can't be completed while abroad. Additionally, you want to ensure you can obtain any necessary equipment the employer provides prior to leaving and **a VPN to access US sites abroad**.

A VPN is also necessary in maintaining a US job overseas, as it "masks", for lack of a better term, your international location. See how to acquire a VPN as well as other beneficial technology related information here.

If you are currently employed, investigate remote work options through your current employer before searching for something new. Additionally, we recommend setting aside a portion of your income to save as money to use after you've made your exodus, as well as a portion to use to purchase tickets and PCR tests (these a no longer required to travel in several countries).

We strongly suggest while still in the states to take advantage of any government subsidies offered due to the worldwide covid "plandemic" and other recent outbreaks, i.e., stimulus, unemployment, child tax credit assistance, etc. *All this is advised based on governmental authorities, but faith is ultimately what's required for YHWH to bless you in your return.
