Mosquito Control Exemption Reminder


Residents wishing to opt out of the MD Department of Agriculture's mosquito control program for 2024 must fill out an exemption <u>form</u> and mail it to the MDA.

Smoke testing will be conducted on all sewer lines on April 23rd and 24th. You may see smoke coming from manholes during testing - this is normal.




