Ordinance 1-2022 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe amending the Trappe Zoning Ordinance, Title III and Section 2 to add definitions of “Junk”, “Junkyard”, and “Storage Yard”; and to amend Title IV, Section 6 to permit storage yards by special exception in the C-2 Highway Commercial District. *(available for adoption)*

Ordinance 3-2022 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe adopting a General Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023, and establishing a tax

rate of \$.33 per \$100 of assessed real property value and a tax rate of \$.54 per \$100 on all commercial or business personal property and public utilities; and establishing an annual fee of \$_____ per residential household for trash collection services, and also adopting an Enterprise Budget for the Town's Water and Sewer operations.
