Ordinance 2-2021 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe to amend Section 14 of the Trappe Town Code titled “Water and Sewer”, table 1 titled “Fees and Charges” to increase the monthly water usage rate to \$4.70 per thousand gallons, and the monthly sewer usage rate to \$10.95 per thousand gallons. *(available for introduction)*

Ordinance 3-2021 – An Ordinance of the Town of Trappe adopting a General Budget for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, and establishing a tax rate of \$.33 per \$100 of assessed real property value and a tax rate of \$.54 per \$100 on all Commercial or Business Personal Property and Public Utilities; and establishing an annual fee of \$130 per residential household trash collection services, and also adopting an Enterprise Budget for the Town’s Water and Sewer operations. *(available for introduction)*
