Two File as Candidates for Town Council

The Town of Trappe will hold an election on May 14th for two open seats on the Council. Those that have filed to run by the deadline of March 19th are incumbents RD Diefenderfer and Tonya Pritchett. The winners will be elected to a four year term beginning with the June 5th Council meeting and will serve with Walter Chase, Norm Fegel and Nick Newnam who were elected in 2017.

The election will take place in the Council Meeting Room at the Town Hall (4011 Powell Avenue) between the hours of 7 am and 7 pm. Absentee ballots are available until May 7th by contacting Town Administrator, Erin Braband.
