Nace's Park 3819 Main St

Nace's Park is Trappe's newest park. The park features open space, landscaping, benches, and a paved walk/trail. The large concrete patio is a flexible space for any type of event.

Veterans Park 3928 Main St

Veterans Park is located at the former site of Trappe High School. The gazebo offers a shady, relaxing place for park patrons. The park also features picnic tables, benches, and a water fountain.

Trappe Park 3924 Main St
