BAG YOUR LEAVES

Please DO NOT rake leaves into the street or onto the sidewalks. This is dangerous as wet leaves can be slippery. Sweeping leaves into the street also clog the gutters and stormdrains causing drainage issues. Please bag your leaves for pickup on trash day, add to your compost, or use for mulch.



Reminder—the trash company will pick up a maximum of 6 bags of trash and/or yard waste per week.

Anything additional will be left behind.
