Town Election - May 11, 2021

In May, voters will go to the polls in Trappe to choose three people to fill the office of Town Councilperson. The open seats will be that of Commissioner Nicholas Newnam, Commissioner Walter Chase Sr., and Commissioner Norm Fegel. Persons interested in running for these positions must be a resident of the incorporated limits of Trappe for one year prior to the election; a qualified voter in the Town of Trappe (at least 18 years of age and a U.S. citizen); and file a candidate application with the Town Administrator/Clerk.

Important Dates

March 16, 2021 by 4:00 PM - Deadline to file to run as a candidate

April 13, 2021 - Primary Election (if seven or more people file to run for office)

May 4, 2021 - Last day to request Absentee Ballot

May 11, 2021 - General Election

Polls will be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM on May 11, 2021 in the Council meeting room at the Town Office.
