Interested in Public Office?

In May voters will go to the polls in Trappe to choose two people to fill the office of Town Councilperson. The open seats will be that of Commissioner Robert (RD) Diefenderfer, Jr and Commissioner Tonya Pritchett both of whom are eligible to run again. Persons interested in running for these positions must be a resident of the incorporated limits of Trappe for one year prior to the election; a qualified voter in the Town of Trappe, (at least 18 years of age and a US citizen), and file a candidate application with the Town Administrator/Clerk. Important deadlines are:

4 p.m. March 19th - Last day to file to run as a candidate

4 p.m. April 1st - Last day to register to vote

A primary election will be held on Tuesday, April 9th if seven (7) or more people file to run for office. The general election will be held on Tuesday, May 14th. Elections take place in the Council meeting room at the Town Office from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm. See the Town Administrator/Clerk, Erin Braband, for election information.

ELECTION BOARD - OPEN POSITIONS

The Town is currently seeking applicants for 3 open positions on the Election Board. Applicants must be a resident of the Town of Trappe.

As a member of this Board you will assist in the next Town Election which is scheduled for May 14, 2019. Compensation is \$100.00 per Board member per Election.

These positions are currently open and the Town will continue to collect letters of interest until all 3 positions are filled.
