Reminder: Post 911 Address On Your Property

During an emergency, it is critical that responders are able to locate the correct address quickly.

It is strongly recommended that you post the physical 911 address on your property. Addresses should be clearly visible from the street. If the building is more than 50 feet from the street, the address should be posted at the street.

It is recommended that address signs are reflective or placed in a lighted area. Take care to ensure brush and/or debris does not block the sign.
