## Special Election - January 17, 2023

The Town of Trappe will hold a Special Election to fill the remainder of Gregory Fries' term, which will end May 2023. Persons interested in running for this position must be a resident of the incorporated limits of Trappe for one year prior to the election, a qualified voter in the Town of Trappe (at least 18 years old and a US citizen), and file a candidate application with the Town Administrator.

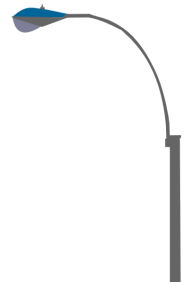
