

The Town of Trappe will be flushing fire hydrants on **July 19th and 20th**

Please do not block hydrants.

Pressure surging and discoloration are normal during this process. Before resuming normal use, you may want to run your water to remove any discoloration.



Water & Sewer Rate Changes

Effective July 1, 2021, the Monthly Water Usage Rate (WATR) will increase from \$4.40 to \$4.70 (per 1,000 gallons). The Monthly Sewer Usage Rate will increase from \$10.28 to \$10.98 (per 1,000 gallons).

All other rates will remain unchanged:

Meter Administration Fee (MAR)- \$7.14 (Residential) - \$9.97 (Commercial)
Basic Water Service (BWS) - \$15.00 (In Town) - \$30.00 (Out of Town)
Basic Sewer Service (BSS) - \$55.00 (In Town) - \$110.00 (Out of Town)
Bay Restoration Fee (BRF) - \$5.00
Late Payment - 2% of past due balance
Turn On Fee (ON) - \$50.00
Turn Off Fee (OFF) - \$50.00
New Account (NEW) - \$25.00
Final Account (FINAL) - \$25.00
