

If the office is not open and you would like to make a payment please use our door slot and be sure to push your payment all the way through. Town Meetings and Planning Commission Meetings are open to the public. Citizens are encouraged to attend to be informed and give input. Meeting agendas are posted outside Town Hall, and items are added as requested (which can be as late as Wednesday morning) and re-posted with each charge. An early agenda is posted on the Town website, but may not always

#### 2024-2025 Water/Sewer Rates

Effective July 1, 2024, the Monthly Water Usage Rate (WATR) will increase from \$4.70 to \$6.20 (per 1,000 gallons). The Monthly Sewer Usage Rate (SEWR) will increase from \$10.98 to \$11.48 (per 1,000 gallons).

All other rates will remain unchanged:

Meter Administration Fee (MAR/MAC) - \$7.14 (Residential) - \$9.97 (Commercial)

Basic Water Service (BWS) - \$20.00 (In-Town) - \$40.00 (Out-of-Town)

Basic Sewer Service (BSS) - \$57.00 (In-Town) - \$114.00 (Out-of-Town)

Bay Restoration Fee (BRF) - \$5.00

Turn On Fee (ON) - \$50.00

Turn Off Fee (OFF) - \$50.00

New Account Fee (NEW) - \$50.00

Final Account Fee (FIN) - \$50.00

Late Charge - 2% of past due balance
