Online Payment Reminder

The only way to pay your water bill via credit/debit card directly to the Town of Trappe is to visit trappemd.authoritypay.com or to call the Town Office. The website can be accessed by typing the link directly into your web browser or by going to trappemd.net and clicking on “Click Here for Online Payments”.

Many third-party billpay companies will have you pay for their service via credit/debit card and then mail a check to the Town of Trappe. Payment confirmation from the billpay company does not verify that the Town received your payment. If you have questions, please call (410) 443-0087.

Water and Sewer Rates

On July 1, 2021, the Water Usage Rate (WATR) will increase from \$4.40 to **\$4.70** (per thousand gallons) and the Sewer Usage Rate (SEWR) will increase from \$10.28 to **\$10.98** (per thousand gallons). All other rates will remain the same as follows: Meter Administration Residential (MAR) \$7.14, Meter Administration Commercial \$9.97, Basic Water Service (BWS) \$15.00*, Basic Sewer Service (BSS) \$55.00*, Bay Restoration Fee (BRF) \$5.00, Turn On Fee (ON) \$50.00, Turn Off Fee (OFF) \$50.00, New Account Setup (NEW) \$25.00, Final Account Fee (FIN) \$25.00, Late Payment Penalty 2.00% of past due balance.

*Rate is double for properties serviced outside of Town limits.
